

Rector's Scholarship

Applications for the **Rector's Scholarship** for the summer semester of the **2024/2025 academic year** are open to second-cycle full-time and part-time students who will be in their **second year (third semester)** of studies started in the summer semester of the **2023/2024** academic year.

Deadline

Application submission period:

From February 27, 2025 – March 6, 2025

Hours: 8:00 AM – 10:30 AM and 11:00 AM – 1:30 PM

Office hours for part-time students:

March 1, 2025, from 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM

Location: Building "J," rooms 101, 102, or 118.

Application Submission

The completed application must be filled out in the USOSweb system, printed, signed, and submitted in person or sent by mail/courier to:

Students from the Faculty of Mechanical and Technological Engineering in Stalowa Wola should submit applications to their faculty office during office hours.

Additional Information

Applications must be completed and submitted within the specified timeframe. After the deadline, due to the limited number of scholarships (up to 10% of students in each program), the USOSweb system will block further submissions, and no applications will be accepted afterward.

Second-year (third-semester) full-time and part-time students must submit:

- A printed and signed application for the Rector's Scholarship for the summer semester of the 2024/2025 academic year titled: "Application for Rector's Scholarship – Summer Semester 2024/2025."

Additional Achievements

Students with additional scientific, artistic, or sports achievements at least at the national level must attach documentation verifying these accomplishments from the period of **February 24, 2024 – February 26, 2025** (covering both the winter and summer semesters) if they began their second-cycle studies in February 2024.

Additional achievements must be listed when filling out the application in the USOSweb system, and documents confirming these achievements from the previous academic year must be attached to the application. While completing the application, students must indicate the reason for applying for the Rector's Scholarship (e.g., for outstanding academic performance, scientific or artistic achievements, or sports achievements at least at the national level). In USOSweb, the appropriate category—academic, artistic, or sports achievements—should be selected.

If an achievement is not listed in the application but is supported by documentation, or if an achievement is listed but not confirmed with appropriate documentation, **it will not be awarded points.**

Consequences of Late Submission

Failure to submit a completed, printed, and signed application to the Office of Student Financial Aid (ul. Podkarpacka 1, 35-082 Rzeszów, Building J, Room 118 – 1st Floor) or to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Mechanical and Technological Sciences within the specified period will result in the **rejection of the application without further consideration.** Late submissions will not be eligible for future Rector's Scholarships.

Application Corrections

We inform you that during the aforementioned dates for completing and submitting applications, it is possible for the coordinator to withdraw a completed and submitted application for the Rector's Scholarship in the USOSweb system in order to correct or supplement it with additional achievements. The application can be withdrawn after the student has notified the coordinator in advance.
